CHURCH ATTENDEES EAT COOKIE AND END UP AT HOSPITAL

ELLETTSVILLE, IN (May 31, 2016): On May 22nd, the Ellettsville Police Department received numerous complaints from attendees of St. John's Catholic Church after morning Mass. Deputy Chief Anthony Bowlen took reports from at least six people who attended the morning Mass and later that day were seen at IU Health Bloomington Hospital for symptoms they described as ranging from nausea, increased blood pressure, anxiety, lethargy and paranoia. Urinalysis screens in those seen by IU Health Bloomington Hospital were positive for Cannabinoids. Each of these attendees claim to have been given a cookie by a fellow church goer after the service.
