ELLETTSVILLE POLICE RECOVER STOLEN VEHICLE

Ellettsville, Indiana (February 20, 2016): Early Sunday Morning, February 19th, 2017 around 2:00 a.m., Officer Zach Michael pulled behind a 2000 Dodge Intrepid that was sitting at the traffic light at Kinser Pike and State Road 46. Officer Michael checked the license plate through NCIC/IDACS and found the vehicle had been reported stolen in Martinsville, Indiana on February 18th. Officer Michael followed the vehicle toward Ellettsville, while Officers from the Ellettsville Police Department and Monroe County Sheriff Department responded to assist. Once Officers were nearby, Officer Michael initiated a high risk traffic stop on the vehicle near the intersection of State Road 46 and Arlington Road. The female driver and male passenger were taken into custody without incident. The female driver was identified as Mallory Rose Lambert (age 21) of Martinsville, Indiana. The male passenger was identified as Jesse Andrew Eggers (age 25), also of Martinsville, Indiana. Both Lambert and Eggers were arrested on the charge of Auto Theft, a level 6 Felony under I.C. 35-43-4-2.5 and transported to Monroe County Correctional Facility.
