DEPUTY JACOB PICKETT FUNERAL – MARCH 9, 2018

Officers from the Ellettsville Police Department had the humbling honor of participating in the funeral ceremony for Deputy Jacob Pickett, Boone County (IN) Sheriff's Office, on March 9, 2018. Deputy Pickett was mortally wounded in the line of duty and passed away on March 5, 2018.

Law enforcement agencies from as far away as Oregon, New York, and Texas were in attendance to pay last respects as well as dozens of local, state, and federal public safety agencies from throughout the Midwest. The funeral route was 52 miles long and included nearly 575 vehicles stretching for almost five miles along the procession.

A memorial fund has been created by the "Fifty Club of Boone County" to support the wife and children of Deputy Pickett. Donations can be made at any KeyBank location, in care of the Deputy Jake Pickett Memorial Fund.
